

Acceptable materials for organics recycling include*:

- **All FOOD scraps**
- ***Non-recyclable PAPER products**
 - **Napkins, paper towels, tissues**
 - **Uncoated paper plates, cups & food containers****
- **All BPI Certified compostable products - certified by the Biodegradable Products Institute (bpiworld.org) and Cedar Grove Certified Products**

Unacceptable materials:

- **PLASTICS of any kind including, styrofoam, plastic bottles, condiment packets, plastic packaging, chip bags & candy wrappers and compostable plastics that do not meet BPI Certification standards.**
- **Fast food wraps, plastic coated paper, freezer boxes, etc.**
- **Milk Cartons, and other beverage cartons.**
- **Cardboard boxes coated in wax.**
- **Wood pallets.**
- **METAL items including: foil, metals, cans**
- **Clothing**
- **Glass**
- **Diapers, sanitary products, pet waste**

**Please note that when purchasing compostable products for waste reduction programs with a composting focus, products should FIRST be selected from the list of BPI Certified or Cedar Grove Certified Materials prior to purchase or inclusion in a program.
